Purpose:

- To recognize and assist deserving and outstanding young people who are pursuing a college degree in agriculture or a related field.
- To promote leadership development within the agricultural sector.
- To encourage students to appreciate the values and opportunities of rural life.
- To foster an interest on the part of young people in Georgia Farm Bureau.

Award:

Scholarships will be awarded to the top ten students who confirm they are majoring in agriculture or a related field.

The top three students will each receive a scholarship of \$3,000. The remaining seven students will each receive a \$750 scholarship.

The winners will be announced in May 2010.

Eligibility:

- The award is available to students whose parents or legal guardians are members of a county Farm Bureau in Georgia as of September 1, 2009.
- The applications must first be approved and signed by the county Farm Bureau president where membership is held before being submitted.
- Students submitting an application **must be** a high school senior for the current academic year and plan to be enrolled in **a unit of The University System of Georgia or Berry College** during the 2010-2011 academic year **pursuing an undergraduate degree in agricultural and environmental sciences, family and consumer sciences or a related agricultural field.**
- A formal high school photo should be attached to each application.
- Each county Farm Bureau may submit up to four applications.
