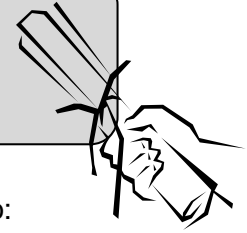

Please read carefully before completing application.

Purpose:

- To recognize and assist deserving and outstanding young people who are pursuing a college degree in agriculture or a related field (see reference page).
- To promote leadership development within the agricultural sector.
- To encourage students to appreciate the values and opportunities of rural life.
- To foster an interest on the part of young people in Georgia Farm Bureau.

Award:

- Scholarships will be awarded to the top ten students who confirm they are majoring in agriculture or a related field.
- The top three students will each receive a scholarship of \$3,000. Each winner will receive \$1,500 for the first year of college upon confirmation of their major and college/university. They will receive the remaining \$1,500 their second year of college provided they maintain at least a 3.0 average their freshman year and their college/university and major remain within the requirements of the scholarship.
- The remaining seven students will each receive a \$750 scholarship upon confirmation of their major and college/university.
- Scholarship checks will be sent to the college/university as confirmed by the recipient and placed in their college account.
- The winners will be announced in May 2012.

Eligibility:

- The applications must first be approved and signed by the county Farm Bureau president where the application is being accepted before being submitted. (This may be in the county where the student resides or the county where the student attends high school.)
- Students submitting an application **must be** a high school senior for the current academic year and plan to be enrolled in **a unit of The University System of Georgia or Berry College** during the 2012-2013 academic year **pursuing an undergraduate degree in agricultural and environmental sciences, family and consumer sciences or a related agricultural field.**
- A high school photo should be attached to each application.
