


Polly and the Birth Day (Book 1 of 4) By D.H. Anderson

- In Georgia horses rank the number 6th commodity by value at just over \$261 million.
- With more than 74,000 horses in Georgia, the breeding and care that go into them is a more than \$750 million business.
- The most common breeds include Quarter Horses, Tennessee Walkers, Paints, American Saddles and Appaloosas.
- · Approximately 4.6 million Americans work in the horse industry which has an economic impact of \$39 billion annually.
- Each year 27 million people in the U.S. ride a horse.
- Cumberland Island has the only herd of feral horses on the Atlantic coast that is not managed (no food, water, veterinary care, or population control.)
- The invention of the first steam-powered tractor in the 19th century marked a significant turning point in agricultural history. Before this innovation, horses and oxen were the primary sources for plowing fields and completing other labor-intensive tasks.
- Horses can live 25-30 years. Their eyes are among the largest of any land mammal and are positioned on the sides of the head. This means horses have a range of vision of about 350°.
