Fun Facts:

- Sheep have been raised in Georgia and throughout the Southeast for centuries. Georgia is now home to just under 10,000 sheep.
- Across all 50 states, there are about 5 million sheep being raised. The Rambouillet, related to the Merino, is the most common breed of sheep in the U.S.
- Sheep are famous for their thick, fluffy fleece which is a popular source for yarn, clothing and other wool textiles.
- Sheep also contribute to various industries by providing milk, cheese, Lanolin, lamb, mutton, and leather.
- One sheep produces anywhere from 2 to 30 pounds of wool annually. The wool from one sheep is called a fleece. The amount of wool that a sheep produces depends upon its breed, genetics, nutrition, and how often they are sheared. Lambs produce less wool than mature animals. Rams, due to their larger size, usually produce more wool than ewes of the same breed or type.
