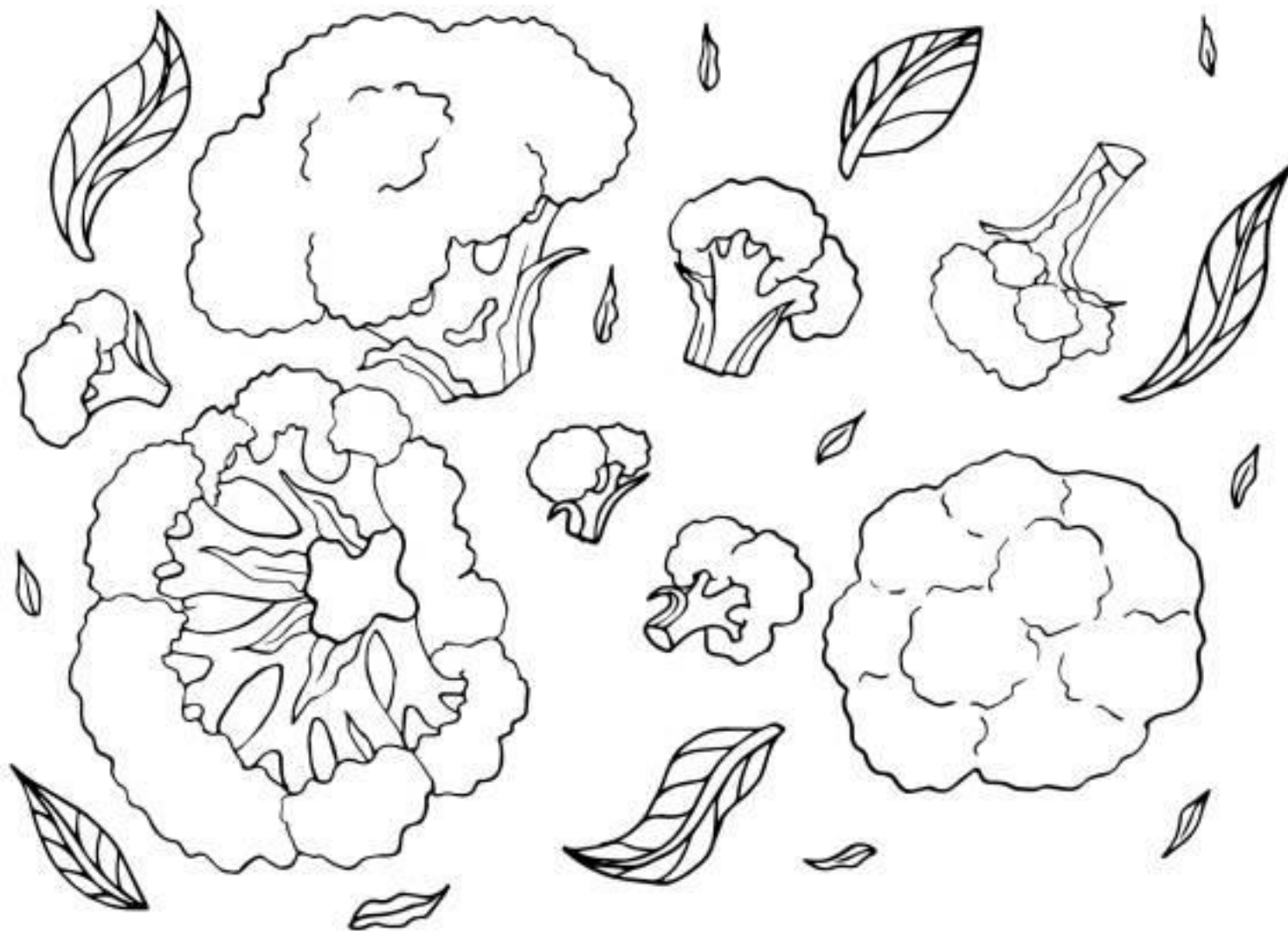




Cabbage is a cool-weather vegetable that grows well in Georgia during the spring and fall. It takes about 2 to 3 months to grow. Georgia is one of the top cabbage-growing states in the U.S.! Farmers here grow lots of cabbage, which is full of vitamins and great in salads, soups, and slaws.



Birds, bats, ladybug, butterflies, moths, flies, beetles, wasps, small mammals, and most importantly, bees are pollinators.
