



Georgia grows squash almost all year long! We grow both summer and winter squash, making us one of the top squash-producing states. Summer squash, like zucchini, has soft skin and is picked when it's young. Winter squash, like pumpkins, has hard skin and is picked when fully grown. Farmers harvest summer squash every day of the year, with the most available in late spring. Winter squash is picked from late August through March.
