



Visit GFB Certified Farm Markets around the state and earn prizes!

Certified Farm Markets are farms across the state that invite you to visit them. They are verified by Georgia Farm Bureau to be an actively producing farm with the commodities they grow listed on website at the bottom of this page.

OFFICIAL RULES

HOW IT WORKS

As you visit participating farms, ask the farmer to stamp your passport. The more stamps you receive, the more prizes you will earn!

1. Be sure to check the farm website/social media or call before visiting to make sure the farm is open.
2. One passport allowed per person.
3. You **MUST** be present to get a stamp. If anyone takes an extra passport with them for a stamp, they will lose 2 stamps per extra passport in their possession and per report. Additionally, the extra passport owners will lose 2 stamps.
4. Only one stamp per farm.
5. We strongly encourage a purchase at each farm as the farms must pay to be in this program. Farms are allowed to require a purchase for a stamp.
6. Passports must be stamped between March - December of the program year printed on cover.
7. Deadline to submit a Farm Passport is the **5th of January the following year**. Don't worry, we'll return it to you with your prizes.
8. Do not call or try to visit a farm in their off season.
9. Respect farmers' privacy & farm boundaries.
10. A current Georgia Farm Bureau membership is required to attend the 20 stamp level prize event, the farm tour and meal. One membership covers a married couple and dependents. Travelers are required to join/renew before submitting their passport. Joining and renewing is easy, see back cover for details.

HOW TO EARN PRIZES

5 stamps - Limited Edition T-shirt

10 stamps - Awesome Ag Swag (*see last page) + T-shirt

20 stamps - Farm tour with Farm to Table meal for one in spring of next year + T-shirt + Ag Swag (*see rule #10 above)

30 stamps - Special Selection of Certified Farm Market Goods (*see last page) + All of the Above

All stamps - Everyone who goes to every single farm in a single year to get their stamps will receive The Traveler Jacket



HOW TO CLAIM YOUR PRIZES

Step 1

Fill in your information on the next page.

Step 2

Submit your passport information on www.gfb.org/PassportSubmission at the end of your travels.

Step 3

Mail in your whole Farm Passport by **January 5th of next year. (Address on page 7)**

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- As you visit, share your journey with **#farmpassport** **#gafarmbureau**
- If you have questions or would like to receive quarterly emails of what is in season, farm events and recipes, email **cfm@gfb.org**.
- Farms are greatly affected by the weather; it can shorten, lengthen, delay, or speed up a crop's season or close the farm for a day(s).
- Review the "Icon Legends" from time to time to recognize when a farm is cash only, has special events/activities you should look up the date for, or offers educational classes you can ask about.
- When reading the following maps, note the bold, white lines are interstate highways and the red lines are either U.S. highways (shields) or state highways (circles.) Thin white lines are county outlines.

Download the Goosechase App on your smartphone. Once in the app, choose to play as a guest or create an account.



Next, search for the name of the Experience (GFB Farm Passport) or enter our unique join code: **49PF1P**. And use the password: **Georgia**



To earn points, complete missions from the list. Mission types include photo submissions, text replies and checking in at specific locations.



Have fun completing missions that will enhance your Farm Passport travels. The app has a live leaderboard so you can see where you rank and enjoy seeing each other's progress. Special prizes will be given out at the end of each season's round.

Optional: You can compete as a solo traveler or as a team (max 4 people.) If team, one person will create a team name and be assigned a team password that they can then share with their teammates to join on their phones.

This is a big year for our country; it's our 250th birthday! Learning to cultivate the land is what made it possible for early settlers to make their homes here. Georgia, specifically, has a rich history in agriculture, which we will dive into this year through the passport games and our farm tour and meal events.

This year in the Farm Passport's history, we're adding a fun new side quest where participants can win additional prizes by competing in an online scavenger hunt. *(Details on page 5.)* Through the missions, participants will embark on fun challenges and enjoy getting to know other travelers through the online and in-person community.

COMMODITY PHOTO MATCH

As we celebrate the 250th birthday of America this year, let's test our Georgia history of inventions and new methods of production that have had lasting impacts on agriculture nationwide.

DRAW A LINE FROM THE AG FACTS ON THE LEFT TO THE CORRESPONDING PHOTO ON THE RIGHT.

1. In 1793, Eli Whitney invented a machine that mechanized the process of separating fibers from their seeds which dramatically increased this commodity's production.

2. In 1949, James Shepherd developed the first combine harvester, a machine that could do multiple steps included in harvesting while moving through the field, for this specific commodity, a design that is still the basis for modern combines.

3. Dr. Bill Branch has created 30 varieties of this commodity, but 2 in particular are disease-resistant cultivars that has enabled our state to grow this commodity on a large scale (we produce over 50% of the nation's supply.) One of those varieties was released in 2006 and accounts for 85% of planted acreage in GA and surrounding states.

4. In the early 1940s, Jesse Jewell revolutionized this industry with vertical integration, contract farming and flash freezing which all combined has made great strides in making this commodity the state's largest commodity.

5. In the early 2000s, a team of scientist at University of Georgia created a precision agriculture tool called Variable Rate Irrigation which controls this resource's application rates based on GPS guidance.
